Not only does this improve the quality of instruction given but it allows instant feedback for swimmers.



Paul Smith, MD of Swim UK said, "It is a great achievement to be shortlisted for the South East Technology Showcase as it is unusual for a "swimming" related organisation to be linked to a new technology award". The final of SETS takes place on 2nd April, with nominees given the opportunity to present a 10 minute example of their innovate e-learning application.
